Angela Ferrante decided to become an attorney when she was a little girl.

“My father was a bit of a frustrated lawyer,” she said. “He had his own businesses, and he sued people a lot. He would take me to small claims court, and I would sit and listen to the conversations. In small claims court, you hear all kinds of interesting things. I realized the power of understanding the rules of the game of life. I wondered, how can you possibly win a game if you don’t understand the rules?”

Ferrante went on to earn her Juris Doctor from Brooklyn Law School. She practiced at law firms Weil, Gotshal & Mangers and Akin Grump Strauss Hauer & Feld before joining Garden City Group, a legal administration firm, nine years ago.

Based in GCG’s East Coast headquarters in Lake Success, Ferrante was recently promoted to senior vice president of operations. In this role, she is responsible for the oversight and management of class action settlement administrations, restructuring and bankruptcy matters, mass tort set-

tlements, regulatory settlements, legal notice programs and data breach response programs.

“Prior to my promotion, I was on the bankruptcy team, but now I will be running both the class action teams and bankruptcy teams in New York,” she said.

It’s a big job, given that the New York office administers about 300 bankruptcy and class action cases at any given time and has about 110 employees.

“Working on legal administration requires extreme attention to detail while knowing the law and applying all the skills that being an attorney teaches you,” Ferrante said.
